The Consolidated Public Water Supply District of Schuyler County (CPWSD #1) is requesting to make improvements and build additional storage capacity to insure a consistent and safe water supply in the county. This is needed because the demands for rural water have increased. With the approval of the bonds, this can be accomplished at no additional cost to rural water customers. The bonds allow the water district to fund the water storage, additional lines, and increased maintenance from future district earnings. This is not a tax. The bonds are a conservative method to make necessary improvements while sustaining our rural independence.
